Widow/Widower – Receive God's blessing and permit the body of Christ to provide for you through this ministry!

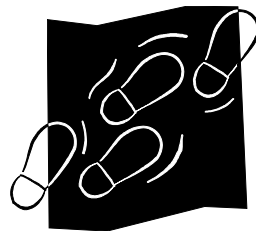
Illness in household – Is the chief chef ill or caring for a family member who is? Help out and take home a few meals, soups, and deserts.

Traditional Meal Ministry plus Meals On Hand = Added Care

Where the situation permits, the Traditional Meal Ministers will be able to supplement their ministry effort by delivering homemade frozen meals, soups, and deserts along with their freshly prepared meal for that evening.
